

BYLAW NO. 149

SUMMER VILLAGE OF YELLOWSTONE

BEING A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF YELLOWSTONE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF A SPECIAL CONSTABLE/BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SUCH POSITION.

WHEREAS, Section 210(1) of the Municipal Government Act S.A. 2000, c.M-26, as amended, provides that Council may establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer;

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Council deems it proper and expedient to enter into an agreement to establish the position of Special Constable/Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Yellowstone in the Province of Alberta hereby enacts:

1. That the position of "Special Constable/Bylaw Enforcement Officer" be established with the duties of such office as outlined in the attached agreement which forms a part of this bylaw and is identified as "Appendix A".
2. That Lac Ste. Anne County, contracted to provide Special Constable/Bylaw Enforcement Officer Services, be appointed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the aforementioned agreement.
3. This bylaw shall be considered null and void upon termination of the attached Agreement, identified as "Appendix A".

This Bylaw shall have force and take effect on the final reading thereof.
