

BY-LAW 76-84

A BY LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF YELLOWSTONE, ALBERTA TO  
APPROVE A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON A REGIONAL SANITARY LANDFILL  
TO BE CONDUCTED BY ALBERTA ENVIRONMENT.

WHEREAS the municipal solid waste from the Summer Village of  
Yellowstone is presently being disposed of in a modified  
landfill; and

WHEREAS some of the modified landfills are near or at capacity;  
and

WHEREAS the Summer Village of Yellowstone is interested in  
minimizing the potential damage to the environment from the  
improper disposal of refuse; and

WHEREAS Alberta Environment has a program whereby it will  
conduct a feasibility study for a regional sanitary landfill.

NOW THEREFORE the council of the Summer Village of Yellowstone  
in the Province of Alberta hereby agree that Alberta Environment  
will be commissioned to conduct the feasibility study; and


IT IS AGREED that the council of the Summer Village of Yellowstone,  
Alberta, with adjoining municipalities, will receive, study  
and evaluate the feasibility study report, and thereafter make  
a recommendation.


