

BY LAW 94

A BY LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF YELLOWSTONE TO APPROVE A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON A REGIONAL SEWAGE LAGOON.

WHEREAS the municipal sewage waste from the summer Village of Yellowstone is presently being disposed of in a manner not in accordance with environmental regulations ; and

WHEREAS haulers are using fields for disposing of sewage; and

WHEREAS the Summer Village of Yellowstone is interested in minimizing the potential damage to the environment from the improper disposal of sewage; and

WHEREAS Alberta Environment has a program whereby it will conduct a feasibility study for a regional sewage lagoon.


NOW THEREFORE the council of the Summer Village of Yellowstone in the Province of Alberta hereby agree that Alberta Environment will conduct the feasibility study; and


